

**ENDED – Flood Watch (Kliniklini) - High Streamflow Advisory – Central Coast
(Bella Coola, Homathko)
ISSUED: 11:15AM July 2, 2021**

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** to a **Flood Watch** for:

- **Kliniklini River**

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** to a **High Streamflow Advisory** for the **Central Coast** including:

- **Bella Coola River and tributaries**
- **Homathko River and tributaries**

Extreme temperatures have eased through the region, resulting in decreased snow and glacier melt rates at high elevations. River levels have peaked, and are now receding.

The [River Forecast Centre](#) continues to monitor the conditions and will provide updates as conditions warrant.

A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
